Ladies please join us for **Women's Bible Study** on Tuesday mornings at 10:00AM in Fellowship Hall.

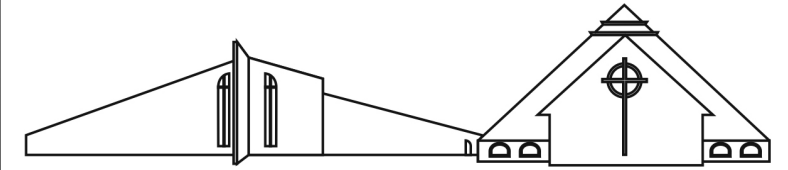
